

29. No person shall drive or cause to be driven a heavy truck on a highway or part of a highway where "no heavy truck signs " are erected or are on display on any highway between the limits set out respectively in column 1,2 and 3 of Schedule "VIII" to this By-law.

30. <u>EXEMPTIONS</u>

- (a) deliveries to a location on a no heavy truck route;
- (b) the performance of services on a no heavy truck route;
- (c) proceeding to or from a garage or the relocation for the purpose of housing, storing or repairing a heavy truck on a heavy truck route;
- (d) public services by the Corporation;

DEVIATION TO BE DIRECT

31. Every deviation onto a no heavy truck route as set out in section 30 of this By-law shall be made from a highway which is not bound by a no heavy truck route to the nearest point of distance to the premises or location of performance of services.

WHEREAS Section 210 paragraph 123. of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-45, provides that by-laws may be passed by Council of a municipality for regulating and prohibiting heavy traffic on the highways; and

WHEREAS, The Corporation of the Township of North Plantagenet deems it desirable to do so;

THEREFORE the Council of the Township of North Plantagenet enacts as follows:


- 1. In this by-law:
 - a) **"heavy truck"** means the use of a highway by a vehicle, object or contrivance for moving loads, having a gross weight, including the vehicle, object, contrivance or load in excess of 4,500 kilograms;
 - b) **"highway"** includes a common and public highway, concession, street, avenue, parkway, square, place, bridge, viaduct or trestle, any part of which is intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles and includes the area between the lateral property lines thereof.
 - (c) "Municipal Law Enforcement Officer" shall mean the Municipal Law Enforcement Officer appointed by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of North Plantagenet.
- 2. No person shall drive or cause to be driven a heavy truck on a highway or part of a highway as defined by Schedule "A" hereto attached. The aforesaid schedule may be varied by resolution of council from time to time as required. The revised version of Schedule "A" must be dated, signed and attached to this by-law.
- 3. The following shall not apply to Section 2 of this by-law:
 - a) deliveries to a location on a no heavy truck route;
 - b) the performance of services on a no heavy truck route;
 - c) public services by the Township of North Plantagenet.

- 4. The provisions of this By-Law shall be enforced by the Municipal Law Enforcement Officer
- 5. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction thereof shall forfeit, and pay a penalty for each such offence and every such penalty shall be recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, chapter P.33 and amendments thereto.

When a person has been convicted of an offence under this by-law, the County Court of the County of Prescott and Russell, or any court of competent jurisdiction thereafter, may, in addition to any other penalty imposed on the person convicted, issue an order prohibiting the continuation or repetition of the offence or the doing of any act or thing by the person convicted directed toward the continuation or repetition of the offence.
- 7. The requirements of this by-law are severable. If any requirements of this by-law are held invalid, the application of such requirements to other circumstances and the remainder of this by-law shall not be affected.
